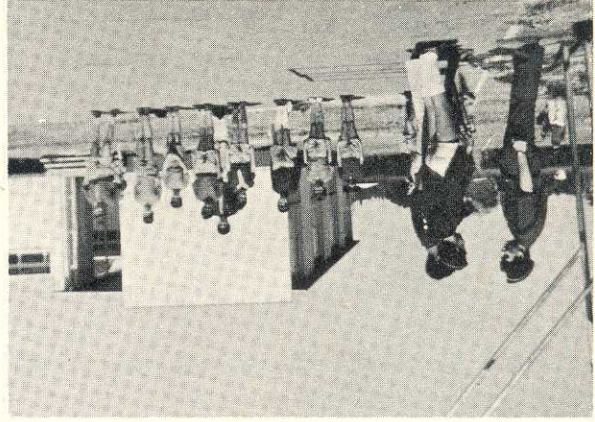


"Shimshies" and "Hashies" at work and at play.

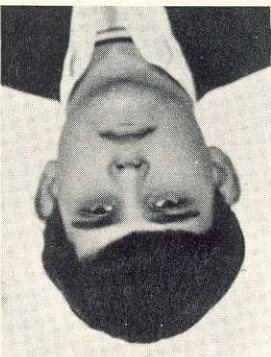
Joseph Galante
