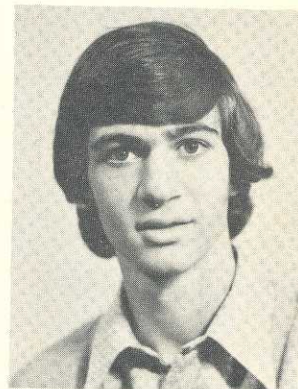


Message from the Mefaqued Maoz
