For what a shrivelled and pitiful thing is that kind of Religion which is only an affair of Chucches Synagogues; of special times and special occasions and Nothing more!!! I would then dare ask:

"What is the value of that Man's faith whose

fellow-man is not better for it?

% Whom it does not impel to do something for the

common weal?

In whom it does not kindle a zealous spirit to diffuse light and warmth and joy in the life of others?

I therefore, call upon your idealism; upon your religious earnestness; upon your moral leadership and repat the words of the rophet EZRA:

Yes,Mr. Mayor and follow Concillors, the matter is now yours; it belongeth to you; yet we are with you; be of good courage and perform it".

May the Almighty God in His infinite mercy, grant that ye may be tru to your great trust, and that we, citizens of no mean city, may fullfil our sacred responsibilities, and thus, dedicate purselves to the service of our God and to humanity.
