I wish to apologize for the delay in replying to your letter of April 24th , for which I thank you on behalf of my Committee. The enclosed copy of the order of Service is very much appreciated.

We are very pleased, that you will perform the filling in of the letters and also bring with you the necessary quill pen and ink. -

As we will invite members of all the Congregations on the Copperbelt for the occasion and some of them have to travel a considerable distance,we found it necessary to start the celebrations in the afternoon, as it would be getting much too late in the evening and many visitors would have to leave before we had finished. We trust, this will meet with your approval.

I made enquiries from C.A.A. and was told, that the Sunday plane leaves Salisbury at 6 A.M. to arrive here 9.25 . The Consegretions at the Cemetery could then take place approximately 11 A.M. Sufficient time should then be left for lunch and a welcome rest until approximately 4.30 when the Service should be held.

A provisional booking for your overnight stay from Sunday night to Monday has been made at the Rutland Hotel.


